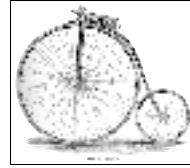

Contest Rules for NWONA Alternative Commuter Contest

Definition: Alternative Commute: Transportation by means other than a single occupancy motor vehicle, which is accomplished by using a bicycle, tricycle, unicycle, feet, vanpool, carpool, or train.

- Record each day that you do **NOT** drive alone.
- Log miles alternatively commuted to work, school, and errands daily.
- **Recreational miles do not count.**
- Individual prizes will be awarded for those who commute alternatively the greatest number of days AND those who log the most miles.
- There will be no team competition.

Other neighborhood associations beware: Next year you will be challenged.
